

EUROPEAN CHAMPIONSHIPS

Women Teams

Originally held in Scheveningen, The Netherlands, in 1932, the European Bridge Team Championships became the principal competition organized by the European Bridge League for teams representing the member countries.

It started as a single series competition for open teams, but in 1935, a women teams series was added. *The 1937 championships in Budapest were "upgraded" to World Championships.*

From 1940 to 1947 the Championships were interrupted because of World War II.

Starting from 1948 the Championships were organized under the auspices of the newly reconstituted European Bridge League.

From 1960 it was decided that the European Championships would not have played in the Olympic year to avoid coinciding with the Olympics.

From 1975 it was decided that the championships will be played only in odd years.

Since 2002, the European Team Championships are held every even-numbered year.

All in all, England and France are won most gold medals in the *open* series (with 13 gold medals, against France's 12 and Denmark's 6).

The undisputed star of the championships is English Rixi Markus who has managed to win between 1935 and 1975 as many as 10 editions of the competition.

In 2010 the Women series will be played as a single complete round robin with all teams playing each other. It is anticipated that matches will be of 20 boards.


