The World Junior Individual Championship is a biennial open event without restrictions to Under 26 players from around the world that was organized by the WBF Youth Committee of the World Bridge Federation for the first time in 2004 and which was meant to be replicated, since 2007 in every odd year but did not. Instead, it followed up until 2010, when it was inserted in the World Series.
